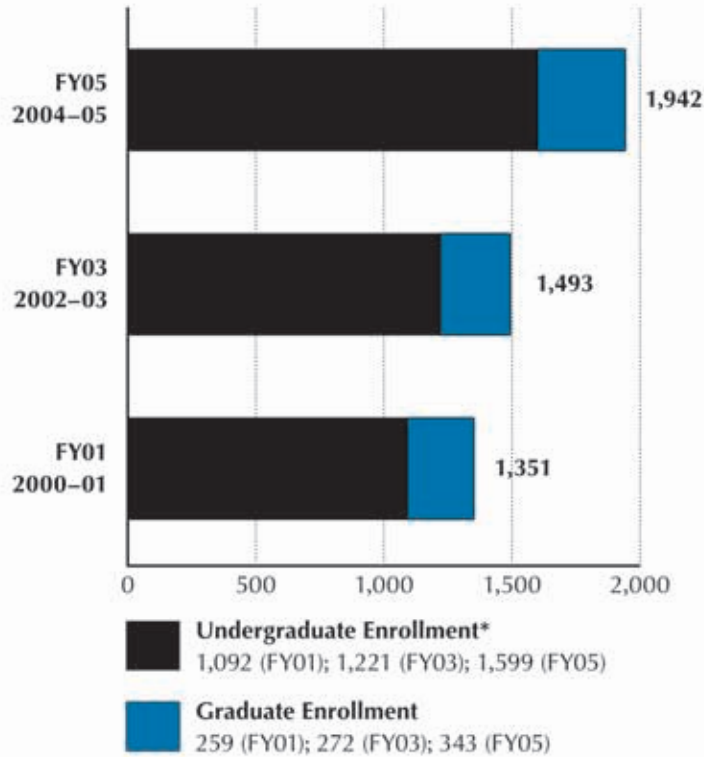

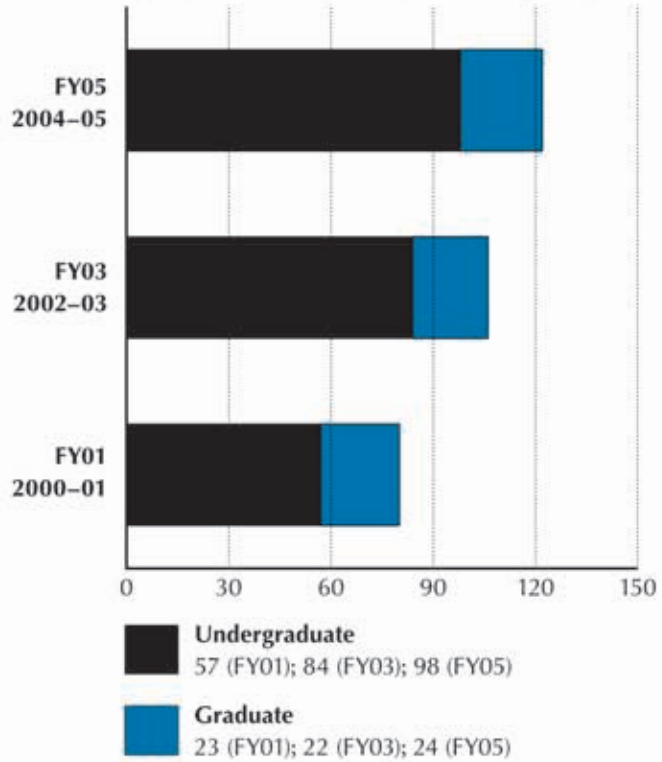
HPER Student Majors



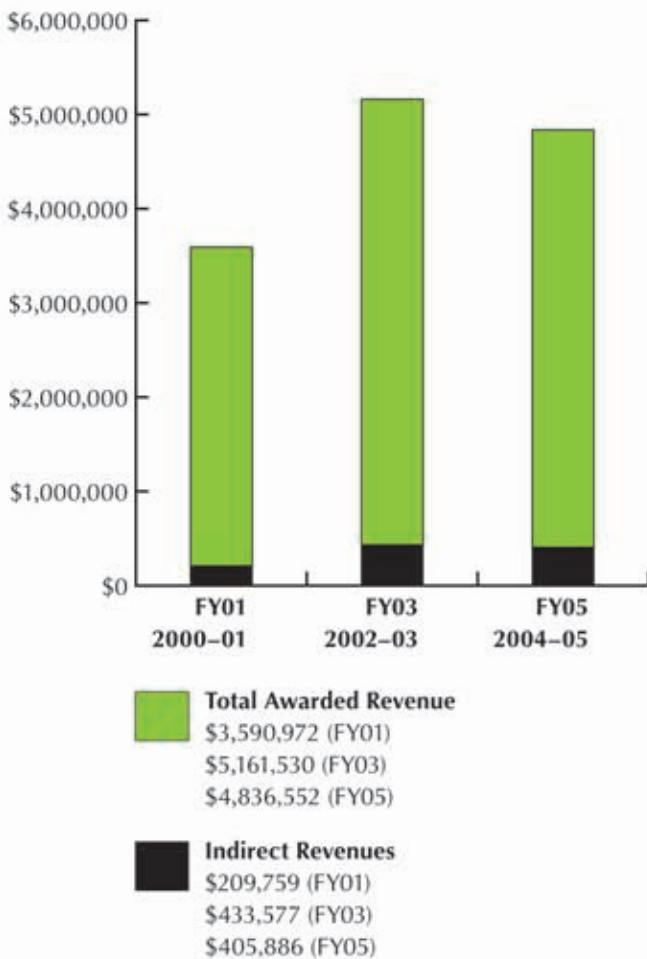
